While summer is often a season of sunshine and growth, for Horse Haven of Tennessee, it marks one of the most critical and demanding times of the year. As the temperatures climb, so do the calls for help—horses left in fields with no food, no clean water, no shade, and no relief from the blistering heat.

In the past few weeks alone we've taken in over 25 horses, with more pending intake as neglect cases continue to surface across the state. Many of these horses arrive in heartbreaking condition; emaciated, dehydrated, and suffering from heat exhaustion. But because of your compassion, these horses now have a safe haven.

Thanks to our incredible supporters, we are able to act swiftly, providing emergency medical care, shelter, nutrition, and eventually—hope for a brighter future. Many of these horses will soon be ready for adoption or foster, and we welcome anyone interested to open their hearts and homes.

But the truth is, we urgently need your help. Our vet bills are growing, hay and grain costs are climbing, and every day brings another call, another life in crisis. We are doing everything we can, but we cannot continue this lifesaving work without your support.

From Darkness to Hope

Earlier this month, we responded to a heartbreaking case—a large group of horses suffering in severe neglect. With only one tree for shade on a small property and no access to proper feed, dozens of horses were battling heat exhaustion, dehydration, and starvation. Several foals showed signs of stunted growth from prolonged malnutrition. Pregnant mares had been bred again and again, and senior mares had clearly spent a lifetime bearing the weight of hardship.

The day they arrived at Horse Haven was the first day of the rest of their lives. As soon as they stepped off the trailers, they went straight to the water, mineral blocks, and fresh hay. Watching them eat, rest, and simply be horses again is a sight we'll never forget. Their bellies are slowly filling out, and so are their spirits.

These resilient souls are now on the road to recovery, and we have many more to care for. With dozens of horses still pending intake, and many already in our barn needing daily care, the





Phase 2 plans include a special-care barn, covered arena, and completing renovations of the existing facilities.

When complete, we will have a 165% increase in rescue capacity, 150%

increase in outdoor shelters, a 167% acreage increase and immeasurable improvement in our rescue response timing and capabilities.

As we embark on Phase 2, we invite you to join the incredible partners that have enabled us to provide the stable future every horse we rescue deserves. We simply could not do this without YOU.

In August of 2024, we quietly launched Phase 1 of our capital campaign and construction effort at our new home. In less than a year, over \$1,169,629 has been raised to fund a beautiful 40-stall capacity primary barn, perimeter and pasture fencing, run-ins, and more!
